

## **ICON MOTORSPORT CONFIDENT OF MORE SUCCESS:**

Having started the season on a victorious note, leading Icon Motorsport driver Ben Morley is again confident of being in a winning position at Sydney's Eastern Creek Raceway this weekend (May 19-20) for the second round of the NSW Formula Ford State Championship.

After claiming pole position and winning the third and final race at round one which was held at Wakefield Park Raceway last month, the reigning NSW State champion will once again look to dominate the second round and build on his current fifth placing in the NSW State Championship point standings.

"At the final round of the championship last year at Eastern Creek we took a more relaxed approach into the round as we had already wrapped the championship at the round previous, so our attack this time around will be completely different as it is in the early stages of the championship," said the driver of the # 1 Spectrum 09B.

"We scored a race win [at the final round of last year] but our grip levels weren't exactly favourable [due to using older tyres], and we are going to be working hard on our setup early this weekend to try and build on the momentum we have this year already.

"In-between rounds we haven't made many changes to the car because we were really happy with the way it ran at Wakefield Park. Apart from making things difficult for myself by an uncharacteristic spin in race one, the car was fine and all is looking good heading into the second round. I'll be making sure I stay up the front all the way through this time!"

Icon Motorsport team owner and also Morley's team-mate, Derryn Harrison, is hoping to build on his 11th placing at round one in the third and final race and focus on moving into the top 10 for the first time this year in his # 66 Spectrum 06B.

"The aim for the weekend is to be inside the top ten in all three races, and I feel given that things fall our way that is achievable," Harrison enthused.

"Lady luck wasn't on our side for the opening round we were caught up in a few incidents, but we finished the weekend strongly with an 11<sup>th</sup> place finish in the final race, so the potential is there for top ten results."

In the Production Sports category, Icon Motorsport driver Brad Gower will return again in the #41 Mazda RX-7 and is aiming to finish inside the top ten outright which again will bode well for capturing class D honours, which was what he achieved at the opening round.
